Tardy Turtle - payment after closing date - £10 per cat		
Substitution fee - show manager's discretion (up to closing date only) - £10 per cat

(Show rule 24.1 “entry will be accompanied by the published fee. No entry fee or related charge will be returned except for failure by the sponsoring club to hold the show as advertised”)

Checking in – 7:45- 8.30 am

Health requirements – this is a **non-vetted** show. Up to date vaccination cards **must** be produced at check in. The show manager reserves the right to remove any cat showing any signs of illness, mites, fleas, fungal infections etc. in accordance with TICA rules. Cats from household where there has been an infectious disease/fungal infection within 21 days of the first day of the show are ineligible for entry. Any cat obviously pregnant or lactating will be disqualified. All claws, front & back, **must** be clipped prior to judging.

Judging is from 9.00am to 5.00pm. Cats may not leave the show hall prior to the advertised hours without the show manager's consent.

Benching – **This is a “bring your own pen” show.** Double SPACES (4ft x 2ft x 2ft) will be supplied by the club. There is a limited supply of metal pens on a “first come, first served” basis, which may be hired at £10. Benching requests should be made with the entry, however no guarantee is made. Litter bins will be provided but **exhibitors are requested to bag their rubbish before placing in the bins.** Exhibitors should supply their own litter trays, litter, cat food & water.

Confirmations – It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to check the confirmation slips issued – please check carefully. If you do not receive a confirmation e-mail before the closing date for entries, please contact the entry clerk.

No flash photography in the hall & **no vending from the benching area is permitted**

Catering – **Please note, there is NO catering in the show hall. Facilities for drinks will be available, but please bring your own drinks container, preferably with a lid for safety.**

Clerking/assistance – if you are able to clerk or help in any way please e-mail the show managers. Clerks will be paid - £30 per day. All clerks will receive lunch

Kittens – Any kitten entered must be at least 4 calendar months but less than 8 calendar months on the date of show. Neutered kittens may be entered.


Household pets – HHP's over 8 months of age must be neutered or spayed.

EW Regional Fund – a donation per cat will be made to the Western Europe Regional Fund. Additional funds are gratefully accepted, especially as this is a fundraiser for the region.

Registration – In order for a cat to be shown without a registration number, that cat must be eligible for registration and competition in TICA in the class in which the cat is to be shown. No entry shall be accepted without a TICA registration number unless documentation is provided with the entry that shows the entry is eligible for registration in TICA. Such documentation includes, but is not limited to the following: a. TICA litter registration; b. TICA breeder slip; c. Registration certificate from any association TICA recognizes; d. Certified pedigree from any association TICA recognizes; e. Registration certificate of both of the parents of the entry by either c or d above. Documentation must be submitted with the entry form..

Show rules – TICA show rules will be strictly enforced. By entering all exhibitors agree to abide by the decisions of the judges and show committee. The official show rules may be obtained from \$7.00 from TICA, PO Box 2684, Harlingen, TX 78551 or www.tica.org
